Job Summary: We are seeking a compassionate and detail-oriented LCSW (or Intern), Registered Nurse (RN), or Health Coach to support patient care through education, follow-up, and care coordination. This role works closely with providers to help patients understand abnormal lab results and develop actionable plans to improve their health outcomes.

General Administrative Duties:

- Able to work general office machines (computer, copier/fax) and willing to learn how to use medical equipment as needed.

Duties:

- Interact and collaborate with providers and other health care professionals for providing a good quality of care for the patient
- Aid providers in coaching patients
- Coach patients through abnormal lab results
- Create coaching plans to help patients achieve healthier lives
- Hand out blood pressure cuffs, glucometers, water bottles, and other items to help patients achieve healthier lives
- Refer patients to other providers for further education in areas such as nutrition and diabetes management

Qualifications

Qualified individuals must be licensed or certified in a specific area. We are not able to host uncertified medical personnel. Each volunteer will only practice within her scope of practice.

Education:

Must be a LCSW, LCSW Intern, RN, or Health Coach.

Time Commitment

One four hour shift weekly with a nine-month commitment to serving. Preferably on Tuesday mornings from 9am-1pm but this is flexible. Once staff is confident in the abilities of the volunteer, the commitment may be served remotely.
